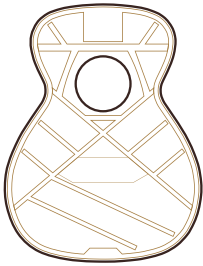


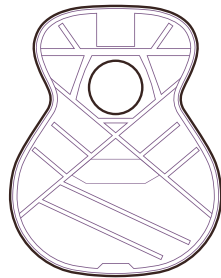


ACOUSTIC GUITAR NAMING STRUCTURE

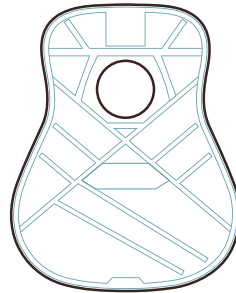
★ START WITH DETERMINING THE BODY SHAPE:



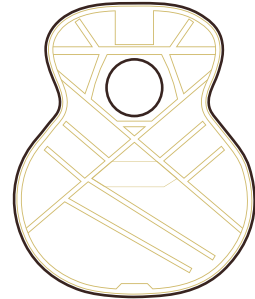
M = CONCERT



OM = ORCHESTRA



D = DREADNOUGHT



F = JUMBO

THEN DETERMINE TONE WOODS...

20 = All Mahogany

40 = Spruce / Mahogany

50 = Spruce / Rosewood*

+5 = Specialty, Flagship

*unless specified as Maple in the model name [ie: F-55 Maple]

THEN DETERMINE THE CLASS...

+ 0 = All-Solid, USA Made

+ 100 = All-solid, Import

+ 200 = Solid Top, Arched back, Import

ARE THERE OPTIONS?

CE = With Cutaway & Electronics

E = With Electronics

12 = 12-string

LH = Lefty

WHICH FINISH?

NAT = Natural

ATB = Antique Sunburst

VTB = Vintage Sunburst
